b.abt.1134, Shropshire, England,
Knight Banneret (Living 1151)

m.abt.1163 in Shropshire, England, Marianna Berkeley (b.abt.1148 in Shropshire), daughter of Sir William Berkly, Knt.Bt.

Sir MARMADUKE Knt.Bt.

b.abt.1163, Shropshire, England.

Sir Marmaduke attended King Henry II to Toulouse in 1160.

Sir HENRY Knt.Bt.

b.abt.1177, Shropshire, England (Living 1187).

m.abt.1195, at Brewood, Staffordshire, England, Mabella Cole (b.abt.1180),
daughter of Sir Ralph Cole, Knt, of Staffordshire.

Sir WILLIAM Knt.Bt.

b.bef.1199

m.abt.1230, in Shropshire, England, Esabella West (b.abt.1210), daughter of Sir John West from whom descended the noble
family of West, Lor Delawar.

Sir William lived temporarily within King John's household.

The Hon THOMAS Esq. (Fowkes)

b.abt.1235, in Shropshire, England. (Living 1247)

m.abt.1259, Alice Vere (b.abt.1240, in Sible Hedingham, Essex, England), daughter of Sir Hugo Vere of Shropshire, Knt.

Sir JOHN Knt.Bt.

b.abt.1260, at Shropshire, England

m.abt.1484, in Shropshire, Dorothea Brown (b.abt.1263, at Montacute, Somerset, England, daughter of Sir John Brown Knt,
of Montacute, 'a worthy family of great antiquity'.

Sir RICHARD Knt.Bt.

b.abt.1285, in Shropshire, England, d.1333, in Scotland.

m.Arabella (*Isabel*) Beucham (*Beauchamps*) (b.abt.1290, at Elmley Castle, Worcestershire, England, daughter of Sir John
Beucham of Lancashire.

Sir Richard was killed in the Battle of Halidon, Berwick on Tweed, in 1334.

Sir JOHN (*or Sir Henry - variation*) Knt.

b.abt.1315, in Shropshire, England, died after 1369.

m.in 1369, Mirabelle Harrison, daughter of Sir John Harrison Knt, of Yorkshire.

Sir EDWARD Knt.

m.Juliana Fawn, daughter of Sir Thomas Fawn from whom descended the Lords of Westmoreland.

Sir RICHARD Knt.

m.Ann Allen, daughter of Sir John Allen Knt, of Suffolk.

(*variation: m.Anne Budgell, daughter and coheir of Sir Henry Budgell Knt, of Devonshire*).

WILLIAM FOWKE

m.Ann Eyton of Eyton County, Shropshire, England.
